

Parking for the San Diego Regional CATESOL Conference 2016

Miramar College is conveniently located in the heart of San Diego County.

Location on Campus:

All exhibits and concurrent sessions will take place in the I-building. This is the English building. The English building is clearly labelled and is conveniently located near the front of the campus, so it should be easy to spot when you turn into the campus. The plenary will take place in the auditorium in the L-building. This is a short 2-3 minute walk from the I-building, and there will be ample signs and/or volunteers to direct you between buildings.

Parking

Parking is free!

Please park in Lot 1 or Lot 2. However, be sure to avoid parking in designated Hourglass Park/Aquatic Center parking, which are reserved for community members using those facilities. These spots are closer to the park, so if you park closer to the I- or H-buildings, you should be far enough away from the community facilities and reserved spots.

Directions from the South:

Take I-15 north. Exit Carol Canyon Road, and turn left onto Carol Canyon to head west. Turn right onto Black Mountain Road. Turn right onto Miramar College Driveway.

To park in Lot 1, take the first right. Then make an immediate left into the lot.

To park in Lot 2, take the first left. Then take the first right.

Directions from the North:

Take I-15 south. Exit Mira Mesa Boulevard, and turn right onto Mira Mesa Boulevard to head west. Turn left on Black Mountain Road. Turn left into Miramar College Driveway.

To park in Lot 1, take the first right. Then make an immediate left into the lot.

To park in Lot 2, take the first left. Then take the first right.

Final Note:

There is another on-campus event on the day of our conference. This other event will take place across campus in the Sciences building, so it should not interfere with parking for our conference. Nonetheless, it is recommended that you give yourself ample time to find the campus and parking!
